









## Platte River Power Authority provides electricity to Estes Park, Fort Collins, Longmont, and Loveland

## Planned generation resources




Community Solar Solar 20 MW

## Platte River's 2021 projected deliveries



#### 2019 rebates

- Lighting LEDs and controls
- Cooling economizers, controls, evaporative cooling
- Envelope windows, insulation and cool roof
- Food Service cooking and refrigeration equipment, and ice machines
- Grocery refrigeration cases, controls and EC motors
- Office & IT task lighting, ES computers and plug loads controls, thin client, server virtualization
- VFDs up to \$120 per HP, 75 HP max (fans, pumps, compressors)
- Custom cooling towers, compressed air, special controls, etc. (Rebates based on \$0.10/kWh annual savings or \$500/kW)





#### **Lighting: new LED fixtures**

Upgrade type	Rebate amount \$/watt reduced (relative to existing)	New rebate amount with 25% bonus rebate	
LED fixture (fluorescent replacement)	\$1.25	\$1.56	
LED fixture (HID or incandescent replacement)	\$1.00	\$1.25	

#### LED new fixture 25% bonus

- Projects pre-approved after December 1, 2018
- Completed and submitted for payment by November 15, 2019



**Lighting: controls** 

Upgrade type	Rebate amount \$/watt reduced (bonus rebate)	Requirement	
DLC Networked Controls	\$0.50	Must be on DLC list	
Multi-Level Controls	\$0.25	Must be a combination of 2 or more control features





- 25% incentive bonus for new LED fixtures (does not apply to new construction or major renovation upgrades)
- Projects must be preapproved after Dec. 1, 2018
- Completed and submitted for payment by Nov. 15, 2019
