






Platte River Power Authority




Midstream cooling heats up





Applying for rebates just got easier







2020 rebates

- Lighting LEDs and controls
- Cooling economizers, controls, evaporative cooling
- Envelope windows, insulation and cool roof
- Food service cooking and refrigeration equipment, and ice machines
- Grocery refrigeration cases, controls and EC motors
- Office & IT task lighting, ES computers and plug loads controls, thin client, server virtualization
- VFDs fans, pumps, compressors qualify
- Custom cooling towers, compressed air, special controls, etc. (Rebates based on \$0.10/kWh annual savings or \$500/kW)

2020 rebates

Minimal changes

- Brought back the 25% lighting bonus for new LED Fixtures that ended July 1, 2020
- Simplified the lighting rebate offerings (fluorescent/HID rebates are now the same)
- Some Energy Star fixtures went prescriptive

Measure	Incentive (\$/Watt _{Reduced})
LED Fixture	\$1.00
LED Retrofit	\$0.50
LED Lamp/Other	\$0.10
Fixture removal only	\$0.10
Energy Star prescriptive fixtures	varies







Orange Energy Solutions

- Over 4M annual kWh
