Take average of two reduced flushes and one full flush • WaterSense certified • MaP score of 600+ • Recycling required for Fort Collins Utilities customers • Limit 2/account/calendar year

Smart home water monitor	Up to \$50	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Connects to Wi-Fi • Monitors water use at the meter • Detects leaks • Breaks down water use by individual household appliance and fixture • Limit 1/account/calendar year

³ Eligible customers must receive water service from Fort Collins Utilities, City of Longmont or Loveland Water and Power. Electric and stormwater only accounts are not eligible.

Rotary nozzles ³	\$3.00/nozzle	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Minimum 5, maximum 24/calendar year Rotor nozzles do not qualify
Rain sensor ³	Up to \$15 (wired) Up to \$30 (wireless)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Limit 1/calendar year
Soil moisture sensor ³	Up to \$45	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Limit 1/calendar year Must be connected to a permanent in-ground irrigation system and calibrates with the irrigation controller to irrigate when moisture has been depleted from the soil.
Drip conversion equipment ³	Up to \$100	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Converting existing irrigation to drip line watering Limit is \$100/calendar year for various drip conversion projects.
Spigot timer ³	Up to \$50	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Limit 1/calendar year Automatic shut off required
Flow sensor ⁴	Up to \$100	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Limit 1/calendar year Ultrasonic requirement
Master valve ⁴	Up to \$100	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Limit 1/calendar year Installed at the base or just downstream of the back flow device, prior to any connections.
PRV at point of connection ⁴	Up to \$200	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Requires pre-approval from Fort Collins Utilities to ensure proper equipment was installed. Limit 1/calendar year

⁴ Eligible customers must receive water service from Fort Collins Utilities. Electric and stormwater only accounts are not eligible.

Additional requirements

- Used equipment is not eligible for rebates. Certified refurbished equipment sold by the manufacturer is eligible for rebates.
- Water rebates are provided by the utilities listed for each measure. Fort Collins Loveland Water District, Spring Canyon Water District and West Fort Collins Water District customers do not qualify.
- Only 2023 purchases qualify for rebates. Applications for 2023 purchases are required to be submitted no later than January 15, 2024 to be eligible to receive a rebate.
- Proof of purchase required. Proof of purchase must include: date of purchase, price paid, model information to verify eligibility and shipping information if applicable.
- Fort Collins Utilities requires proof of recycling for toilet rebate. Recycling locations can be found [here](#).
