#### Clothes washers<sup>1</sup>

Eligible equipment	Rebate	Equipment guidelines
Clothes washer	\$75	<ul> <li>ENERGY STAR certified.</li> <li>Can combine with \$25 electric rebate if account also receives electric service from eligible utility<sup>2</sup>.</li> </ul>

## **High efficiency toilets**

Eligible equipment	Rebate	Equipment guidelines
Tank toilet - <= 1.1 GPF, MaP Premium listed <sup>1</sup>	Up to \$90	<ul> <li>Toilet must be 1.1 gallons per flush (GPF) or less and be on the <u>MaP Premium</u> list to qualify</li> <li>See Page 5 for how to search for MaP Premium toilets, see Page 6 for a list of eligible toilets.</li> <li>Dual flush toilets qualify only if they are MaP Premium listed. Any dual flush toilet with a 1.6 flush does not qualify for MaP Premium.</li> </ul>
Tank toilet - <= 1.1 GPF single flush <sup>1</sup>	Up to \$60	<ul> <li>Toilet must be single flush &lt;= 1.1 gallons per flush (GPF) or less to qualify</li> <li>Dual flush tank toilets do not qualify for this rebate</li> </ul>
Tank toilet – Dual flush 1.1/1.6 GPF	Up to \$30	<ul> <li>This rebate is only available to eligible City of Longmont residential or commercial customers.</li> <li>Toilet must be a 1.1/1.6 gallons per flush (GPF) dual flush tank toilet to qualify.</li> </ul>

#### Smart home water monitor<sup>3</sup>

Eligible equipment	Rebate	Equipment guidelines
Smart home water monitor	Up to \$65	<ul> <li>Connects to Wi-Fi or cellular data</li> <li>Monitors water use at the meter</li> <li>Detects leaks</li> <li>Breaks down water use by individual household appliance and fixture</li> </ul>

#### Showerheads<sup>1</sup>

Eligible equipment	Rebate	Equipment guidelines
Showerhead	Up to \$30	<ul> <li>Showerhead must be 1.5 gallons per minute (GPM) or less</li> </ul>

#### Efficient irrigation equipment (continued on next page)

Eligible equipment	Rebate	Equipment guidelines
Weather-based irrigation controller or add on <sup>1</sup>	Up to \$65	<ul> <li>Rebate is intended for controllers connected to an inground irrigation system</li> <li>WaterSense labeled; add on device will make an irrigation controller WaterSense labeled and able to adapt watering schedules as weather changes.</li> </ul>
Rotary nozzles <sup>4</sup>	Up to \$4.00/nozzle	<ul> <li>Rotary nozzles, or high efficiency nozzles, slowly deliver multiple streams of water – reducing water waste; rotor nozzles or rotor heads and pressure reducing spray heads do not qualify.</li> <li>Minimum of 3 to apply</li> </ul>

Eligible equipment	Rebate	Equipment guidelines
Rain sensor <sup>4</sup>	Up to \$20 (wired) Up to \$40 (wireless)	<ul> <li>Required to be connected to an underground irrigation system</li> <li>Wireless model is also required to be connected to a weather-based irrigation controller that controls an inground irrigation system</li> </ul>
Soil moisture sensor <sup>4</sup>	Up to \$60	• Rebate is intended for equipment connected to a permanent in-ground irrigation system and calibrates with the irrigation controller to irrigate when moisture has been depleted from the soil
Drip conversion equipment <sup>4</sup>	Up to \$130	<ul> <li>Rebate is for converting grass/turf zones to drip irrigation; drip systems installed with a new in-ground irrigation system do not qualify</li> <li>Eligible equipment includes drip hose, conversion heads, emitters, hooks and clamps, risers, etc.</li> </ul>
Spigot timer <sup>4</sup>	Up to \$65	<ul> <li>Timer is required to have an automatic shutoff</li> <li>Rebate is intended for equipment not associated with an in-ground irrigation system</li> </ul>
Flow sensor <sup>4</sup>	Up to \$130	<ul> <li>Flow sensors measure how slowly or quickly water is flowing through an irrigation system and sends that information to an irrigation controller</li> <li>Required to be connected to a WaterSense irrigation controller</li> </ul>
Master valve <sup>4</sup>	Up to \$130	<ul> <li>Installed at the base of the backflow device, which controls water flow into the mainline of the system</li> </ul>
Pressure reducing valve (PRV) at point of connection <sup>4</sup>	Up to \$260	<ul> <li>Large brass valve installed by a professional technician to reduce water pressure to an entire irrigation system; drip system pressure reducing valves do not qualify for this rebate</li> <li>Requires pre-approval by utility staff to ensure equipment was properly installed</li> </ul>

Commercial water customers of Fort Collins Utilities are eligible for some irrigation rebates that are administered via Fort Collins Utilities directly. Please click here for more details.

### Additional requirements (continued on next page)

Rebates are available for NEW equipment only. Used or refurbished equipment does not qualify. •



- Applications must be submitted within 45 days of purchase or installation/delivery. Proof of installation or delivery will be required. Self-certification is not eligible.
- Proof of purchase required. Proof of purchase, or other supporting documentation, must include: date of purchase, price paid, model information to verify eligibility and shipping information if applicable.
- Rebates are limited to 100% of the final retail price paid for the rebated equipment. Rebates are subject to available funds.
- Limits apply either through eligible application cap or by availability of rebate funds. Some measures have a minimum quantity requirement.
- Fort Collins Loveland Water District, Spring Canyon Water District, ELCO and West Fort Collins Water District customers do not qualify for Efficiency Works rebates. Rebates are funded through the eligible utilities listed.
- Utility reserves the right to verify installation of a rebated product.
- Efficiency Works reserves the right to discontinue or change rebates without official notice.
- Recycling of old toilet is highly recommended. New construction does not qualify.
- Commercial customers only total incentive amounts over \$10,000 requires pre-approval and need to be processed through the Efficiency Works Business rebate program. Learn more and apply at <a href="https://efficiencyworks.org/business/rebates/">https://efficiencyworks.org/business/rebates/</a>
- Multifamily properties with five (5) or more units per building and a commercial water meter qualify for commercial rebates. Multifamily properties with fewer than five (5) units per building, or individual tenants, with a residential water meter qualify for residential rebates.
- Rebates not available for showerheads that are directly installed or provided as part of other Efficiency Works programming.
- MaP Premium eligibility will be confirmed using the <u>MaP website</u>. This is done by entering in the model number of the toilet purchased. Model information will be taken from the receipt, other provided documentation, or from a retailer website where the purchase was made. If the search does not result in a toilet being MaP Premium listed, the toilet will not be deemed eligible for the MaP Premium rebate. See example on the following page.





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
