

## Building Operator Certificate (BOC) incentive

Class type	Criteria	Incentive	
Building Operator Certificate Level I or Level II	Attendee must function as building operator for a building 50,000 sqft feet or greater. Proof of class completion and certification completion	\$1,200	per attendee per building

2. Preapproval requires proof of enrollment in Building Operator Certificate class (level I or level II)
3. Final payment requires proof of certification completion
4. Incentive is only available for one operator per 50,000 sq. ft or greater building. If enrolling more than one operator, proof of multiple 50,000 sq. ft. or greater buildings and explanation of roles for attendees is required

#### Incentive details and requirements:

- Incentives are available to building operators of electric customers of Estes Park Power and Communications, Fort Collins Utilities, Longmont Power & Communications or City of Loveland Utilities
- Building square footage must be 50,000 sq. ft. or greater
- All BOC incentives require pre-approval prior to participating in the training



- Proof of class registration is required before preapproval will be issued
- Total incentives are limited to \$1,200 per building operator per building
- BOC incentives are available for each building 50,000 sq. ft. or greater on a single campus, but multiple BOC incentives will not be available for a single building within 5 years of the last paid incentive
- Total incentives are limited to 100% of training costs, as outlined in provided invoices
- Efficiency Works Business maximum incentive limits will apply per project, see Program Guide for details
- BOC incentives are ineligible for any grants being offered in 2026
