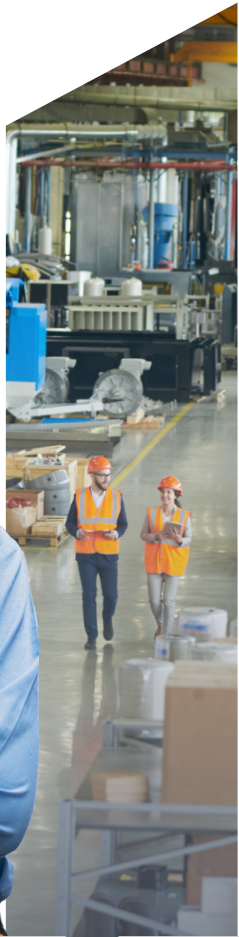




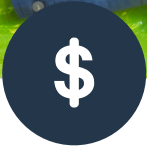

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Building Performance Standards compliance study incentive

Need a more in-depth analysis of your building to identify your path to compliance? Our BPS compliance study incentive uses a network of listed Efficiency Works service providers to conduct assessments for eligible customer buildings. Efficiency Works Business offers an incentive intended to offset some or all of the study's cost. Step 1

Determine whether your building is subject to the State of Colorado BPS. Identify the need for an in-depth study to discover paths to compliance.



Step 2

Contract with a listed service provider to submit a preapproval application and complete the study.



Step 3

Your study results are delivered, final application is submitted and the rebate is processed for payment.

Customers must meet the following minimum eligibility requirements:

- The building is a commercial electric customer of Estes Park Power and Communications, Fort Collins Utilities, Longmont Power & Communications or Loveland Water and Power.
- The building is subject to the State of Colorado Building Performance Standards
- The building is existing and complete, not under construction or planned to be constructed
- Participant has the legal right and authority to install equipment and perform maintenance work on the building.
- Participant agrees to share the final study report with Efficiency Works.

Study incentive details and additional requirements:

Efficiency Works offers different incentives and bonus amounts based on the size of the building, the BPS statute it is subject to, and other qualifications. The customer may be eligible for the incentive amounts below based on the information entered on the incentive pre-approval application, up to 100% of the study cost. For example, a building of 60,000 ft² that is subject to the State of Colorado BPS requirements and also elects to do the electrification study focus would be eligible for up to \$20,000 in incentives. Efficiency Works has the right to modify incentive amounts per assessment at any time if actual results show the incentive is too high or low.

Building Performance Standards bonus	All requirements of the BPS study incentive, plus eligibility requirements outlined in the BPS bonus application. Not available to customers of Estes Park Power and Communications.	\$5,000
Electrification study focus bonus	All requirements of the BPS study incentive, plus electrification study.	\$5,000
